The start of the year has started as the autumn term finished with 4 competitions delivered within a short spring half term!

The events have had 4 different venues; St Paul's, St Anne's and Rock Ferry Primary schools and the Oval Sports Centre. During this half term there were opportunities for all year groups from years 1 through to 6 and for both boys and girls of all abilities. This really emphasises the focus and diverse nature of the Edsential 'Competitions & Events' that are delivered.
