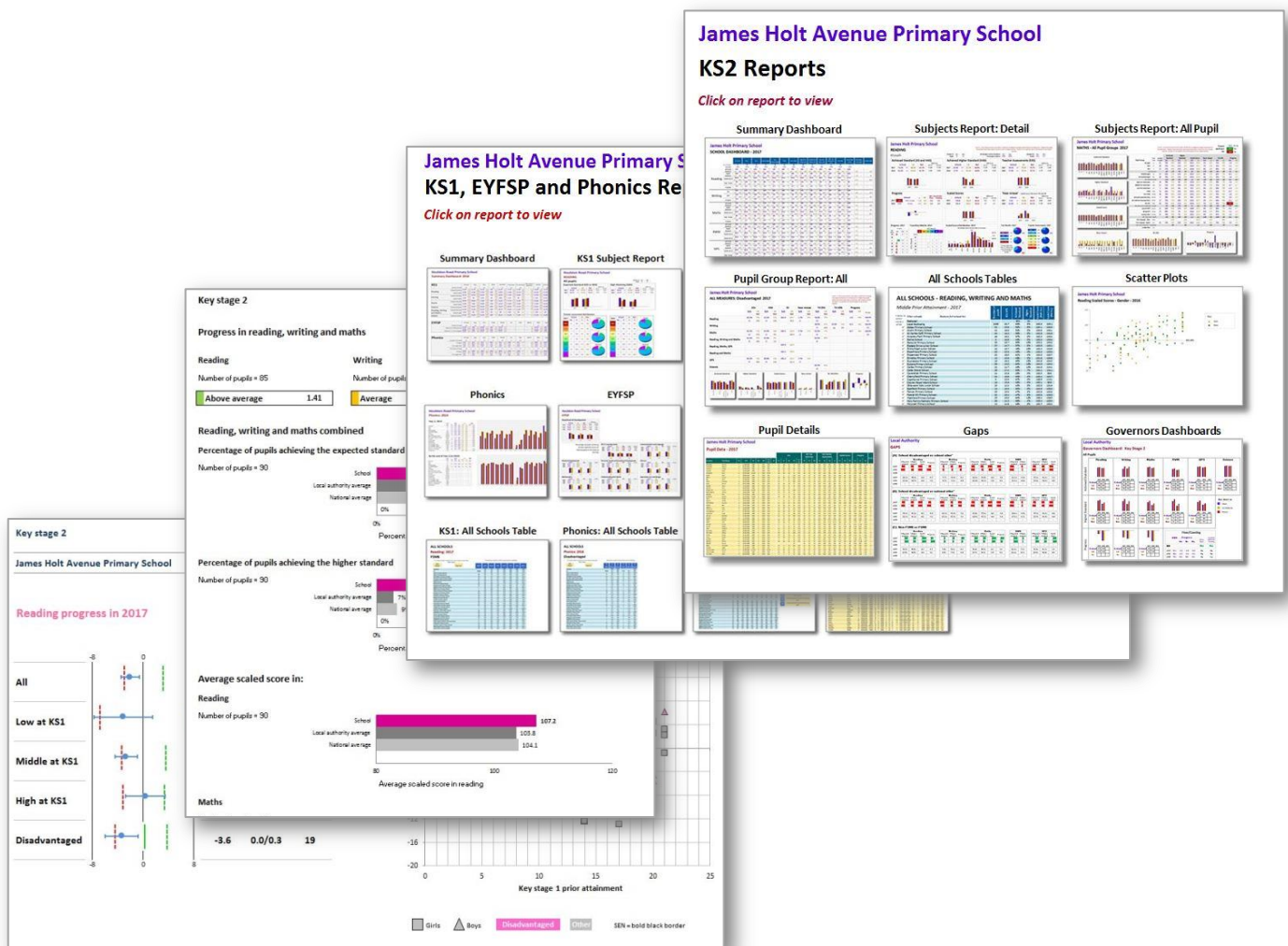

Earliest data available!

The Edsential Data Service provides reports BEFORE THE END OF THE SUMMER TERM. For 2018 schools will receive their first set of reports this July.

The Data Service reports remain the earliest available to schools.

What's included?

- Easy-to-use interactive databases covering **KS2, KS1, Phonic and EYFS**.
- The reports cover the attainment and progress (where applicable) in all the subjects for up to 29 different pupil groups over the last three years.
- The reports allow benchmarking against other schools in the local authority, with headline data across all the indicators and pupils groups for those schools, the local authority and national.
- As the national picture changes – as it inevitably does over the summer and autumn – the reports are updated to include the changes.
- All the reports have tests for statistical significance.
- Multiple report printing: this allows a range of reports to be selected and printed out in one go. This is a feature unique to the Data Service reports.
- Early estimate of the ASP Summary Report
- Early estimate of the Ofsted IDSR Report
- Telephone/email support for queries relating to school's own data, ASP, IDSR and FFT
- **NEW: Governor Training – for schools which subscribe to the Data Service, attendance at any data training session run by the Data Service costs only £25 per governor attending (normal cost: £85).**
- **Wirral schools: included in the Data Service is full access to FFT Aspire and access to NOVA online reports.**

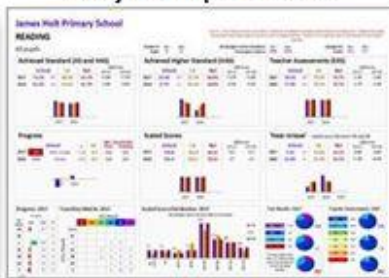

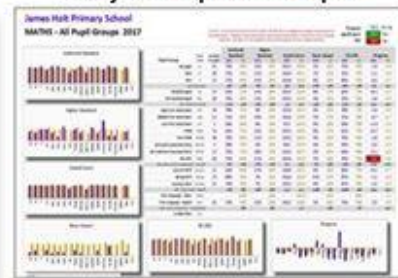

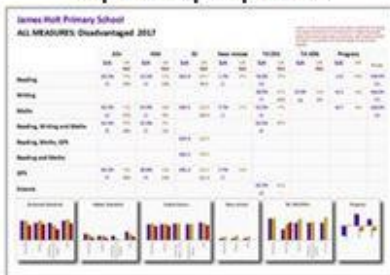
Subjects Report: Detail



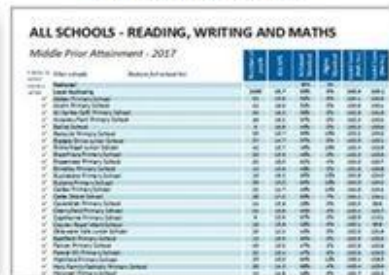
Subjects Report: All Pupil



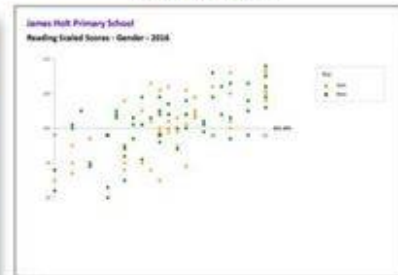

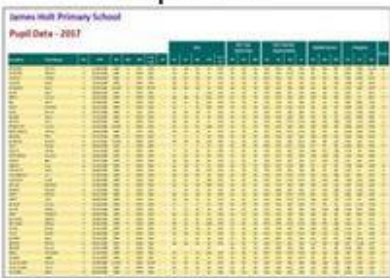

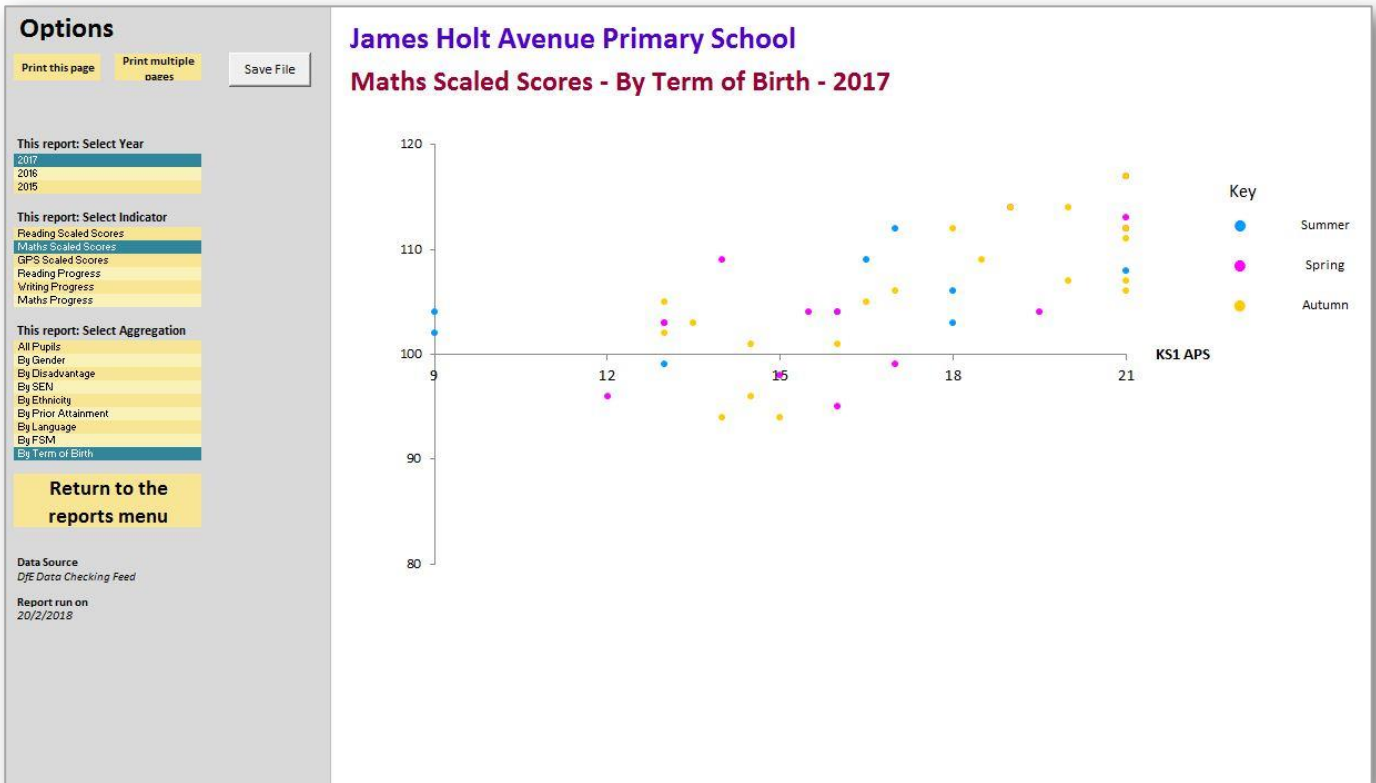

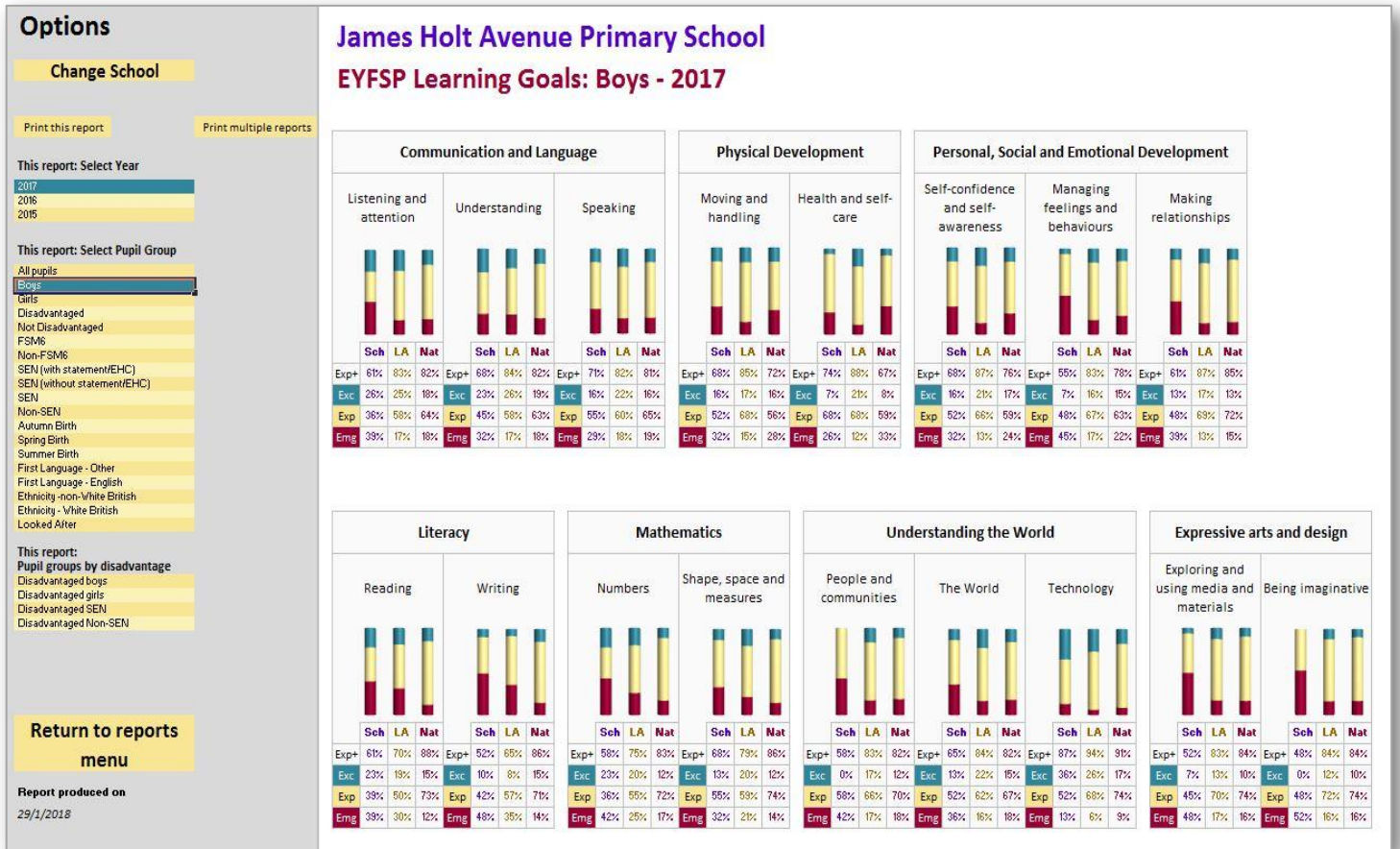

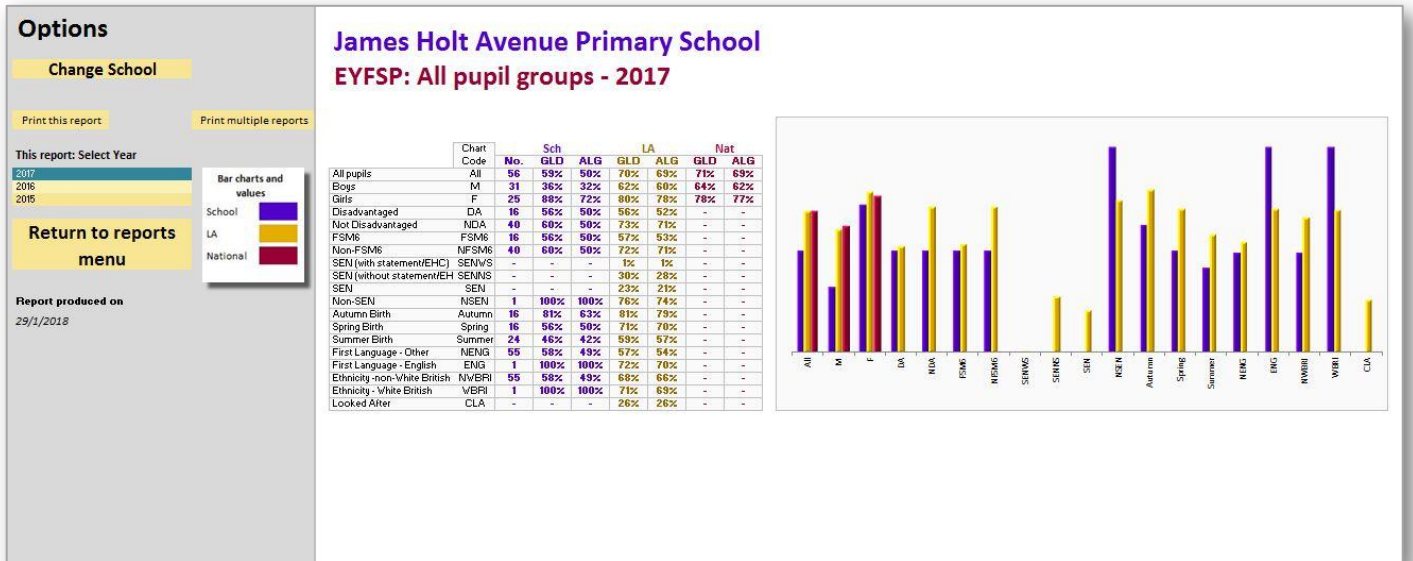

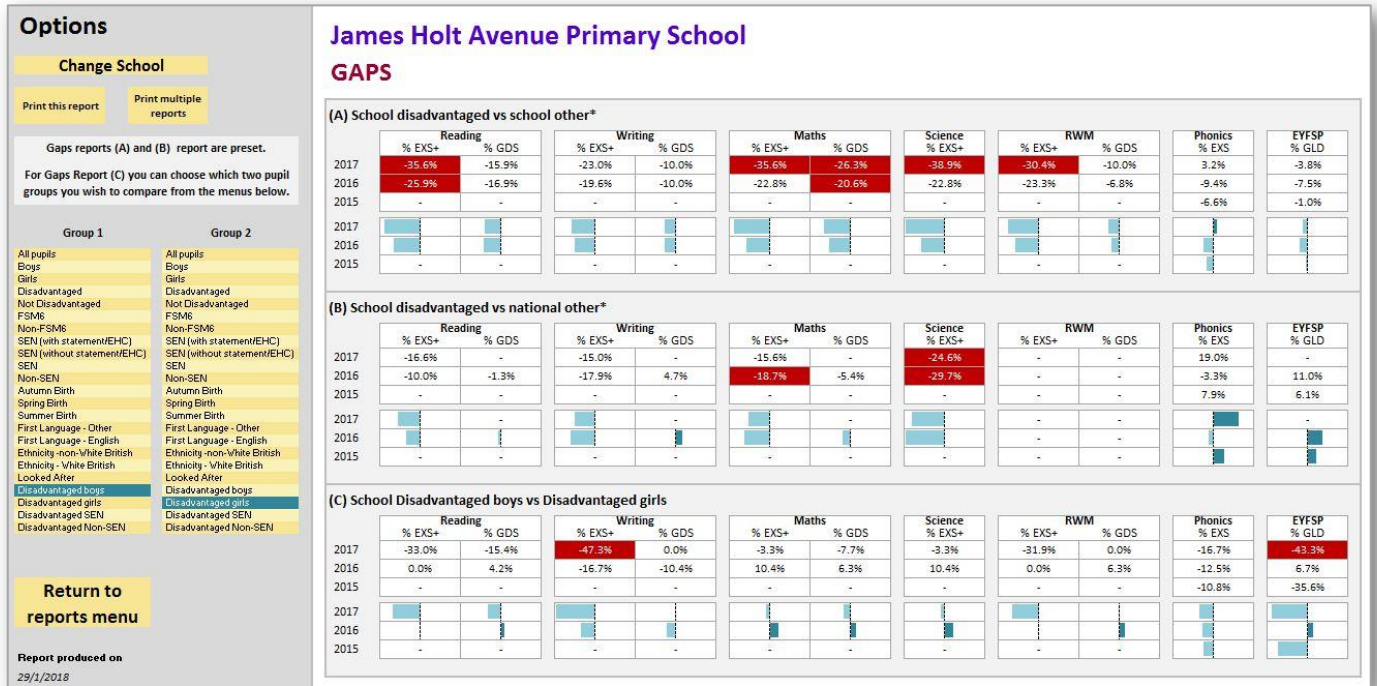
